

## VCH ImmsBC – System Updates – Sept 12th, 2024

Enhancements below will primarily impact VCH in-clinic users responsible for vaccine administration and data remediation.

Changes anticipated for ImmsBC include:

1. **Changes required to rename existing LTC/AL and remove C19 Reason for Imm dropdown values**
2. **Users are able to select and save Inactive clinics in their User defaults**
3. **BUG:**
  - a. **ICE deferral picklist values are not displaying correctly**
  - b. **Vaccine Administration Summary page shows incorrect value when back-entering in ICE**
  - c. **Active deferral banner appears wherever you navigate. User must click X or refresh**

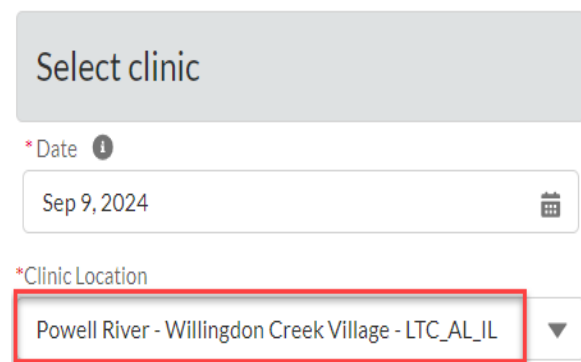
**\*Changes required to rename existing LTC/AL and remove C19 Reason for Imm dropdown values**

### ***What's New?***

This change will ensure that applicable 'Reason for Immunization' field values in drop down are updated to align with the renaming and removal of values in PIR.

The purpose of the LTC/AL name change is to support BC pharmacists in choosing the correct Location by standardizing the naming conventions for all Health Authorities. BC pharmacists are now able to document the administration location (i.e. an LTC or AL facility), while also identifying their "Pharmacy Billing Location" separately.

The purpose of the removing select values and the "C19" prefix from "Reason for Immunization" dropdown is to better reflect the ongoing work and use of the ImmsBC application post pandemic.

When a User is setting up their user defaults and they populate the 'Reason for Immunization' field they will no longer see below values for selection:

- C19 Community
- C19 Pandemic Priority Population
- C19 Hospital/Acute
- C19 Physician

They should now see the below updated values available for selection:

- 'C19 AL Resident' to '**AL Resident**'
- 'C19 AL Staff; to '**AL Staff**'
- 'C19 LTC Resident' to '**LTC Resident**'
- 'C19 LTC Staff' to '**LTC Staff**'

The values should be reflected in the ICE and DIWA workflows and the immunization record as well.

**\*Users are able to select and save Inactive clinics in their User defaults**

**What's New?**

This bug fix enables users the ability to select inactive clinics in their user defaults.

The expectation is that even with the clinic being set as inactive, the clinic will appear in the clinic location drop down when setting user defaults. This is meant to support data remediation efforts, but block net, new vaccine administration documentation against an inactive location.

It is still permitted to use Inactive Clinic Locations for back entry documentation purposes, when using Create Immunization Record (previously DIWA) workflow.

**\*Bugs**

**a. Bug: ICE deferral picklist values are not displaying correctly**

Some agents are appearing with a long code (e.g. 0hsAs00000001kDIAQ) after selecting the agent name (e.g. Influenza-Inactivated).

**b. Bug: Vaccine Administration Summary page shows incorrect value when back-entering in ICE**

After User Defaults are set to match the back entry date and location - On the vaccine admin summary page, the “Date of Administration” shows today’s date (date of submission).

The purpose of the summary page is for users to confirm details before submitting. The discrepancy in dates and/or labels is misleading. Upon saving, the correct date is displayed in the Related tab.

**c. Bug: Active deferral banner appears anywhere you navigate. User must click X or refresh the page.**
